David Zervos was born in Kos, in the Dodecanese region, and graduated from the Hippocrates General High School of Kos. After graduating, he entered the Department of Sociology at the University of the Aegean (Mytilene) through entrance exams (panhellenic exams), where he completed his undergraduate studies from 1999 to 2003, graduating with honors. In 2006, he completed his postgraduate studies with a grade of Very Good at the Department of Political Science and Public Administration of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens (NKUA). Then, on June 16, 2021, after becoming a PhD candidate in the Department of Sociology at the University of the Aegean and successfully defending his dissertation (which was graded Excellent) on May 28, 2025, he was officially awarded his PhD in the Department of Sociology at the University of the Aegean. On July 1, 2025, he became a postdoctoral researcher in the Department of Sociology at the University of the Aegean.
